


Age, Gender and Race Composition Across Surveys

Demographics of Veteran Survey Samples




Ideological Composition of Military Veterans Across Surveys


Vast Ideological Gaps Emerge on Trump's EO Abolishing DEI in the Military

Vast Ideological Shifts in Veteran Perceptions of Military's Direction Since 2024


